

# Avian Influenza Report

**VOLUME 10, NUMBER 45**

Reporting period: November 2 – November 8, 2014 (Week 45)  
(Published on November 11, 2014)

## Summary

1. There were no new human cases of avian influenza A(H5N1) reported by the World Health Organization (WHO). <sup>#</sup>
2. From 2008 to 2013, 32 to 73 confirmed human cases of avian influenza A(H5N1) were reported to WHO annually. In 2014 (as of November 8), 19 cases were reported by WHO<sup>^</sup>.
3. During this reporting period, there were no new human cases of avian influenza A(H7N9). Since March 2013 (as of November 8, 2014), there were a total of 456 cases reported.
