## **Terms of Appointment**

Members are appointed by the Director of Health. The initial term of office is three years. The Board will meet at least once a year to discuss longer term plans, but may be convened on an ad hoc basis for matters requiring urgent attention. Papers may be examined and members' views sought by circulation.

## **Privileges and responsibilities**

2. The privileges and responsibilities of BOSA members include -
  - (a) Representing CHP/DH in public/official functions, as the Controller may deem fit.
  - (b) Access to and use of data owned by CHP for research and publication of scientific papers, subject to existing Departmental rules governing approval and use.
  - (c) Information obtained from CHP, irrespective of the means whereby it is obtained, should be confined for use in work related to the CHP and not be released to outside parties except with the express agreement of the Controller.
  - (d) Making a declaration of interests.
