## VI Packaging specimens for the Courier Service

- 1. Place specimen container in a plastic bag with the request form outside the bag. Then place the specimens in a rigid container, and keep specimens upright to minimize the possibility of spillage.
- 2. Specimens to be sent via the Courier Service of the Department of Health should be segregated according to specialties as detailed in various sections of this Guide.
- 3. Place specimens for each specialty within separate transparent plastic bags with the designated coloured label as follows:
  - Histology & Cytology Blue
  - Microbiology
    - Blood specimens (Serology) Virology specimens (Culture) White
    - Microbiology studies (excluding molecular, serology & mycobacteriology) Yellow
    - Mycobacteriology (TB) Pink
    - Molecular studies Orange
  - Chemical Pathology & Haematology (CPHD) Green
- 4. Please ensure that specimens for CPHD are packed separately in a transparent plastic bag containing the green label of CPHD. Do not place any specimen from other specialties into the CPHD bag.
- 5. Hand over specimen packs to the Courier Service for delivery to the laboratory according to the timetable of the calling points.
