Dear Principals/Person-in-charge,

First Cluster of Local Human Swine Influenza (HSI) Cases in Hong Kong

I am writing to update you the latest situation of HSI (H1N1/Influenza A) in Hong Kong.

Over the past two days, the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) confirmed the first cluster of local HSI cases in a secondary school involving 12 students. The cases have no identifiable link to any known source. Having assessed the latest situation, the Government's Steering Committee on Pandemic Strategies announced today a 14-day class suspension in all primary schools, kindergartens, kindergartens cum child care centres and special schools from 12 June 2009 to 25 June 2009. The Education Bureau and the Department of Health will closely monitor the development and will decide whether classes to be resumed or continue the suspension after the 14-day period.

We are now entering the early mitigation phase of the disease control strategy for HSI. Class suspension is one the important measures of social distancing to mitigate the progression of HSI pandemic, students should therefore be advised not to go to crowded places during this period unless absolutely necessary.

School management should refer to the "Guidelines on the Prevention and Management of Human Swine Influenza in Schools" for measures to be adopted during class suspension and preparations for class resumption. The guidelines are available on the CHP website at:
