

Human Swine Influenza Vaccination for Children

Special Arrangement for Residents of Outlying Islands

Starting from 11 January 2010, three Maternal and Child Health Centres (Tung Chung MCHC, Cheung Chau MCHC and Mui Wo MCHC) under Family Health Service of the Department of Health will provide human swine influenza (HSI) vaccination to eligible children aged 6 months to below 6 years who are residents of outlying islands.

Parents/Guardians can visit the following MCHC during the child health service session to arrange HSI vaccination for their child. When coming with their child, parents/guardians should bring along valid identity document showing Hong Kong resident status of their child (both original and photocopy are accepted) and original copies of all their child's immunisation records, e.g. DH6.

Telephone booking is not provided. Medical/Nursing staff will arrange HSI vaccination for eligible children during the same service session as far as possible. If the child has fever or the waiting time for vaccination is too long, medical/nursing staff will arrange another appointment for HSI vaccination in the next service session.
