
Expand CDCC Pilot Scheme to cover blood lipid testing (launched on 28 Mar 2025) & implement hepatitis B screening (by Q4 2025)

Key Elements of CDCC

- Providing subsidies for the public to conduct screening for and manage targeted chronic diseases including DM and HT in the private healthcare sector
 - Expand drug list and investigation choices including imaging
 - Integrate government subsidised programs e.g. VSS and CRC
- "Family Doctor for All" and Coordinated by DHC/ DHC Express
 - Subsidised for services involving women's health & elderly health (e.g. pap smear)
 - Paired PTs/OTs for first contact arrangement
 - Referral system with HA hospitals
- Brand building for family doctors

Drive Pairing with FD for Long Term Relationship through DHCs



Expansion of CDCC Pilot Scheme - SIV Arrangement for Family Doctors under CDCC

 Doctors who have joined both VSS and CDCC Pilot Scheme in the period specified by the Government (Interested doctors should enrol CDCC before 15 Aug 2025)



 Pilot programme to draw SIV(IIV) from Government contracts at specified quantity for eligible persons under VSS at a price set by the Government (Eligible doctors can indicate the option to draw SIV(IIV) in VSS enrolment via eHRSS by 31 Aug 2025)



Recommendation of Primary Healthcare Blueprint



Enlistment in PCD as pre-requisite for joining existing and subsequent Government-subsidised primary healthcare initiatives such as Vaccination Subsidy Scheme

- Implementation
 - Applied to doctors with effect from 6 October 2023
 - Applied to dentists with effect from 2 January 2025
 - Extend to other professions gradually, including PTs and OTs

New Requirement: PCD doctors to join at least 1 PHC programme

Join PHC programme(s)



Elderly Health Care Voucher (EHVC)

- Elderly person aged 65 or above
- Provide financial incentive for elderly to choose private healthcare services





Colorectal Cancer Screening Programme

- HK residents aged between 50 to 75
- Take a Faecal Occult Blood Test (FOBT)
- If there is blood, colonoscopy will be arranged to remove polyps





Vaccination Subsidy Schemes (VSS)

- including Seasonal Influenza
Vaccination School Outreach
Programme and the Residential
Care Home Vaccination
Programme



- Seasonal Influenza Vaccination (SIV)
- Free or subsidized SIV to eligible persons



Chronic Disease Co-Care Pilot Scheme

- HK residents aged 45 or above
- No known medical history of diabetes mellitus (DM) or hypertension (HT), nor related symptoms


