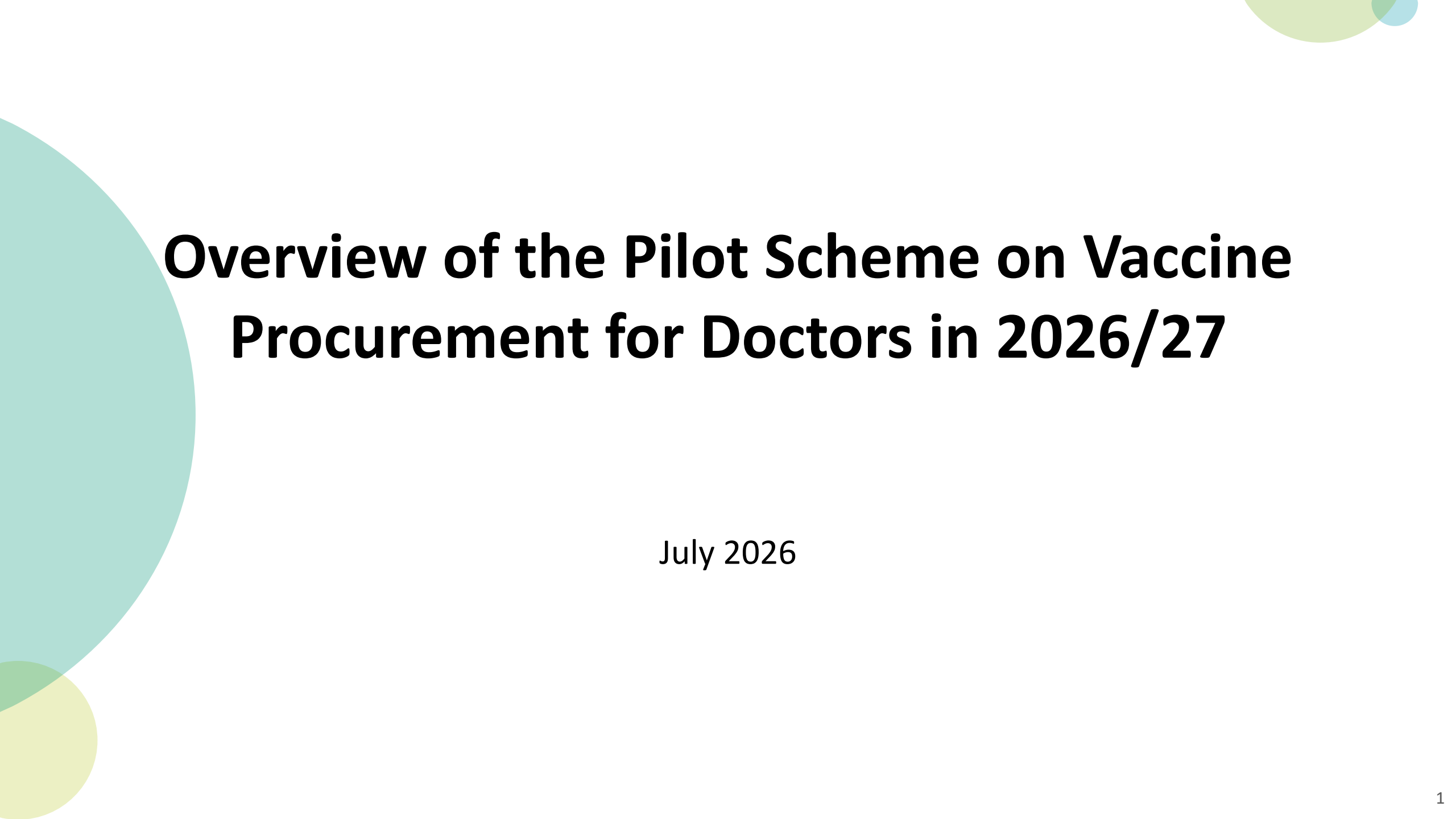

Pilot Scheme on Vaccine Procurement for Doctors – 2025/26

- **Enhance stability** of **vaccine supply** and **ensure eligible high-risk groups** can receive seasonal influenza vaccination
- **Test and build readiness** of supply workflow and related logistics of **vaccine supplier** and **IT system** for future arrangement
- Pilot Scheme on Vaccine Procurement for Doctors
 - **100 000 doses** of **Injectable Inactivated Influenza Vaccine (IIV)** were procured through Government Contract
 - Doctors who joined **both VSS and Chronic Disease Co-Care Pilot Scheme (CDCC)** are eligible to participate
 - Doctor Clinics participated in the Pilot Scheme:
 - Required to provide **IIV** for eligible persons with **co-payment at \$0**, including IIV procured by doctors themselves
 - **Reduce financial burden** and **incentivise** the public for vaccination
- **Overall positive feedback** was received from participated doctors and the 100 000 doses were ordered and delivered in 10 weeks

Pilot Scheme on Vaccine Procurement for Doctors – 2026/27 (1/2)

1. Plan to procure **300 000 doses of IIV** via the Government contracts for eligible doctors to draw from
2. **Expansion of eligible doctor groups** to join the Pilot Scheme
 - Doctors who join VSS and at least one Government subsidised Primary Healthcare (PHC) Programme (estimated **~3,000 doctors**)



Pilot Scheme on Vaccine Procurement for Doctors – 2026/27 (2/2)

➤ **Early August** 2026:

- Specified VSS Doctors can indicate the participation
- Details of Arrangement and Ordering will be announced
