Colorectal Cancer Screening Programme

Asymptomatic Hong Kong residents aged between 50 and 75 should receive regular colorectal cancer screening.

Where to get screened?

- Over 1,000 primary care doctors have enrolled in the Programme
- No co-payments are required in most clinics
