Outreach For School Children 2018/19



- School Outreach Vaccination Pilot Programme 2018/19
 - 1. Department of Health (DH) Mode
 - 2. Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) Mode
- Vaccination Subsidy Scheme (VSS)
 - 1. VSS (extra charge allowed)
 - 2. Enhanced VSS Outreach Vaccination (no extra charge)
- Residential Care Home Vaccination Programme (RVP)
 - Special Schools for Persons with Disabilities (PID)



Vaccination Figures (as at 27.01.2019)



School	No. of schools arranged outreach vaccination activities (%)	
year	primary schools	KG/CCCs
2017/18	65 (11.2%)	60 (5.8%)
2018/19	400 (68.8%)	176 (16.9%)

- > 6-fold increase in number of outreach primary schools
- About 3-fold increase in number of outreach KG/CCCs



Relative Risk of Influenza-like Illness Outbreaks in Schools with SIV Outreach Activities in 2018/19

School year	Relative risk	
	Primary schools	KG/CCCs
2018/19	0.45 (95% CI 0.31-0.66, p<0.0001)	0.63 (95% CI 0.49-0.83; p=0.0007)

 significantly lower proportions of schools with outreach SIV encountered ILI outbreaks



Evaluation on Outreach Flu Vaccination



Views from schools

- Satisfied with the outreach vaccination services provided by VSS doctors
- Difficulties in preparing the consent lists of students (schools lack administrative support)

Views from doctors

- Participating doctors welcomed PPP mode in general
- Suggested increase of injection fee
- Suggested matching by geographical regions
- Time to wait for clinical waste collection

Primary School Outreach



New Features

- Conducted by PPP doctors' vaccination teams
- Schools select their doctors first, if no selection, then DH perform matching
- PPP doctors to prepare a consented student list (in excel format) to be uploaded by DH
- PPP doctors to download reports on eHS(S) for checking before vaccination date
- PPP doctors to arrange collection of clinical waste, temporary storage at schools if cannot arrange same-day collection
- Batch upload of claims by PPP doctors on eHS(s)
- Increased reimbursement to HKD \$100 per dose (includes clinical waste disposal cost)

KG/CCC OUTREACH (PILOT)



KG/CCC Outreach (Pilot)



- KG/CCCs are usually of small sizes (70% less than 200 students)
- Locations are more scattered
- AM/PM/ Full day session

→ Outreach vaccination activities are much smaller scale, some solo practice GPs are able to conduct outreach



KG/CCC Outreach (Pilot)



- 2018/19 Enhanced VSS/ VSS Outreach participation: 176 KG/CCCs
- To increase coverage, DH will introduce a Pilot Programme to test run the feasibility and acceptability



Main Difference from Primary School Outreach

- PPP doctors to purchase, store and deliver vaccines
- Higher reimbursement :HKD\$260 per dose

Advantages:

- allow flexibility for participation of doctors
- allow flexibility to KG/CCCs, activities can be beyond school days



Similarities with Primary School Outreach

- Conducted by PPP doctors' vaccination teams
- KG/CCCs select PPP doctors first, if no selection, then DHmatching
- PPP doctors to prepare a consented student list (in excel format) to uploaded by DH
- PPP doctors to download reports on eHS(S) for checking before vaccination date
- PPP doctors to arrange collection of clinical waste, temporary storage at KG/CCCs if cannot arrange same-day collection
- Batch upload of claims by PPP doctors on eHS(s)

	- DH will facilitate school to find PPP doctor from CHP website
Handling of clinical wastes	Arranged by PPP doctors
Vaccination Date	 Mutually agreed by doctors and KG/CCCs (without DH's coordination) Can be outside school days and hours
Reimbursement	\$260 per dose

VSS School Outreach (Extra Charge Allowed)

New Features

To cover all students in schools irrespective of HK resident status

Other Features

- Extra service fees allowed
- 2nd dose activities and mop-up activities are optional
- Reimbursement HKD\$210 per dose (same as 2018/19)
- School staff/ parents not belonging to VSS eligible groups can be vaccinated at their own costs (managed as a separate session of VSS Outreach)

Types of Vaccines for 2019/20



- Inactivated (IIV) injectable vs. Live-attenuated intranasal (FluMist®)
- Pending Scientific Committee on Vaccine
 Preventable Diseases (SCVPD) recommendation
- To be announced later around April 2019
- Will keep doctors updated
