



# Free for the Young - Co-administration of COVID-19 Vaccine and Seasonal Influenza Vaccine (SIV)

(Free for receiving the first three  
doses of COVID-19 vaccine)



Receiving **free** co-administration with online reservation:

<p><b>Children Community Vaccination Centre</b> (Walk-in available for eligible citizens who are not able to make appointment online)</p>	<p><b>Children aged 6 months to 17 years (Inactivated COVID-19 vaccine)</b> <b>Children aged 6 months to 11 years (mRNA COVID-19 vaccine)</b></p>
<p><b>Designated Maternal and Child Health Centres under the Department of Health</b></p>	<p><b>Children aged between 6 months and 4 years (Inactivated and mRNA COVID-19 vaccine)</b></p>
<p><b>Designated Student Health Service Centres under the Department of Health</b></p>	<p><b>Children aged 3 to 17 years (Inactivated COVID-19 vaccine)</b> <b>Children aged 5 to 11 years (mRNA COVID-19 vaccine)</b></p>

In addition, the following vaccination venues provide **free** or subsidized\* co-administration:

<p><b>Private Clinic COVID-19 Vaccination Stations</b></p>	<p><b>Make appointment for the COVID-19 vaccination via online booking system, and consult the vaccination team directly on the day of vaccination to receive SIV</b> (Walk-in available for eligible children aged under 18 years)</p>
<p><b>Private doctor or clinic under Vaccination Subsidy Scheme</b></p>	<p><b>Search for private clinics under the Scheme and directly contact the clinic for vaccination appointment</b> * additional charge may be imposed by for some clinics, please check with the clinic before visiting for vaccination</p>
