Whether I can have Sinovac vaccine “CoronaVac”



CoronaVac should not be given

- ✗ History of allergic reaction to any component of CoronaVac vaccine or similar vaccines
- ✗ Previous severe allergic reactions to vaccine (e.g. acute anaphylaxis, angioedema, dyspnoea, etc.)
- ✗ Severe neurological conditions (e.g. transverse myelitis, Guillain-Barré syndrome, demyelinating diseases, etc.)
- ✗ Any adverse reaction of nervous system after CoronaVac vaccination
- ✗ Uncontrolled severe chronic diseases
- ✗ Pregnant or lactating women



Precautions – Please consult your doctor first

- ⚠ Acute diseases
- ⚠ Acute exacerbation of chronic diseases
- ⚠ Severe chronic diseases
- ⚠ Atopy
- ⚠ Fever
- ⚠ Diabetes or its family history
- ⚠ History of convulsions, epilepsy, encephalopathy or mental illness; or family history of these diseases
- ⚠ Thrombocytopenia
- ⚠ Haemorrhagic diseases
- ⚠ Impaired immune function (such as malignant tumour, nephrotic syndrome, AIDS)
- ⚠ Use of human immunoglobulin injection
- ⚠ Concomitant use with immunosuppressive drugs or other vaccines
- ⚠ Use of other drugs or undergoing treatment
- ⚠ Persons aged below 18 years
