**Consensus Interim Recommendations on
Co-administration of COVID-19 vaccine with other
vaccines in Hong Kong
(As of 11 August 2022)**

The Scientific Committee on Vaccine Preventable Diseases (SCVPD) and the Scientific Committee on Emerging and Zoonotic Diseases (SCEZD) under the Centre for Health Protection of the Department of Health (JSC) with the Chief Executive's expert advisory panel (EAP) revisited the topic on co-administration of COVID-19 vaccine and made the following recommendation taking reference from the World Health Organization and overseas practice as well as local context.

2. The JSC-EAP recommended that COVID-19 vaccines can be co-administered concomitantly, or at any time before or after any other vaccines (including live attenuated vaccines) under informed consent. If clients or parents of children wish to space out COVID-19 vaccine with live attenuated vaccines, an interval of 14 days is sufficient.
3. The aforesaid interim recommendations provide updates on previous recommendations regarding co-administration of COVID-19 vaccines issued on 6 April 2022.



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
