Statement of Purposes for the Collection of Personal Information by Department of Health on Notification of Infectious Diseases other than Tuberculosis

Specified in the PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF DISEASE ORDINANCE

Purpose of Collection

1. The personal data provided by doctors to the Department of Health (DH) will be

used for the following purposes:-

(a) Epidemiological surveillance;

(b) Notification, investigation and control of statutory notifiable diseases.

The provision of personal data is obligatory under the Prevention and Control of Disease

Ordinance.

Classes of Transferees

2. The personal data you provided are mainly for use within DH but they may also be

disclosed to other Government bureaux/departments or relevant parties for the purposes

mentioned in para. 1 above, if required. Apart from this, the data may only be disclosed to

parties where you have given consent to such disclosure or where such disclosure is allowed

under the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance.

Access to Personal Data

3. You have a right of access and correction with respect to personal data as

provided for in sections 18 and 22 and Principle 6 of Schedule 1 of the Personal Data (Privacy)

Ordinance. Your right of access includes the right to obtain a copy of your personal data. A

fee may be imposed for complying with a data access request.
