<u>Reminder: Hong Kong Childhood Immunisation Programme (2007)</u> <u>to be launched on 1 February, 2007</u>

I refer to my previous letter dated 13 December, 2006 on Hong Kong Childhood Immunisation Programme (2007) and would like to remind you that the updated programme will be effective from 1 February 2007.

As stated in my previous letter, the Scientific Committee on Vaccine Preventable Diseases recommends combined diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis and inactivated poliovirus vaccines (DTaP-IPV & dTap-IPV) be used in the updated childhood immunisation programme, so that children are vaccinated only once during an immunisation visit. The vaccination schedule for DTaP-IPV is 2 months, 4 months, 6 months, 18 months and Primary 1, while dTap-IPV will be given to Primary 6 students. Type I oral poliovirus vaccine (OPV) at birth will no longer be recommended and additional aP vaccine will offer extra protection against pertussis to Primary One and Six students.
