Dear doctor,

New Initiatives for 2018/19 Seasonal Influenza Vaccination

We are writing to invite doctors to join the new initiatives of outreach vaccination for schools for 2018/19 season.

Currently, free or subsidised seasonal influenza vaccination are provided to eligible groups through the following programme/ scheme:-

- a) free under Government Vaccination Programme (GVP)
- b) subsidised under Vaccination Subsidy Scheme (VSS) at clinics of private doctors enrolled in the VSS or in the outreach vaccination activities organised by VSS doctors

In the coming 2018/19, the Department of Health will introduce a number of new initiatives for seasonal influenza vaccination. In particular, the new **School Outreach Vaccination Pilot Programme** and the **Enhanced VSS Outreach Vaccination** (an enhanced programme of the existing outreach vaccination under VSS) will provide free seasonal influenza vaccination to children at primary schools.

Details are as follows:-

The Pilot Programme

The Pilot Programme aims to increase seasonal influenza vaccination uptake amongst **primary school children** and to facilitate **primary schools** to arrange outreach vaccination.

Enhanced VSS Outreach Vaccination at Primary Schools/ Kindergartens/ Child Care Centres/ Kindergarten-cum-Child Care Centres

The Government will enhance outreach vaccinations at <u>primary schools</u>, <u>kindergartens (KGs), child care centres (CCCs) and kindergarten-cum-child care centres (KG-cum-CCCs)</u> under VSS, including increasing subsidies (from HKD\$190 to HKD\$250 per eligible student) for outreach at these institutions and a subsidy for clinical waste disposal (at HKD\$800 per outreach activity).

A new Target Group for VSS in 2018/19

Starting from 2018/19, VSS will be expanded to cover Hong Kong residents aged 50 to 64.

Increase Subsidy for Seasonal Influenza Vaccination

Starting from 2018/19, the subsidy for seasonal influenza vaccination provided to eligible groups at clinics or other non-clinic settings will be increased from HKD\$190 to HKD\$210 per dose. Children aged 9 or below who have never received seasonal influenza vaccination before are eligible for subsidy of 2 doses of seasonal influenza vaccination within the season.

Continuous Medical Education (CME) Requirements

Starting from 2018/19 season, for any doctor who newly applies or continues enrolment in VSS, he/ she should have enrolled in the Primary Care Directory (PCD) first before he/ she is eligible to enrol in the VSS. The Vaccination Office would check whether the VSS doctors are on the PCD list around August 2018. For doctors who have not yet enrolled in the PCD, please enrol before August 2018/19. For doctors who have already enrolled in PCD, please make sure you have acquired sufficient CME points for the CME cycle Jan 2017-Dec 2017 in order to remain on the list of PCD.

The 2018/19 Seasonal Influenza Vaccination School Outreach Vaccination Pilot Programme, Enhanced Vaccination Subsidy Scheme Outreach Vaccination, and Other VSS Outreach Vaccination

Background

In order to lower the risk of serious complications and hospitalisation from seasonal influenza infection, the Government has been providing subsidised seasonal influenza vaccination (SIV) to eligible children aged 6 months to 12 years (or aged 12 years or above but attending primary schools in Hong Kong) under the Vaccination Subsidy Scheme (VSS). Other eligible children may receive free SIV under the Government Vaccination Programme.

Thanks to support from VSS doctors, VSS has been running smoothly providing subsidised SIV to children either at VSS doctor's clinic or at non-clinic settings, such as kindergartens and primary schools.

To increase SIV uptake rate amongst <u>primary school children</u> and to facilitate primary schools to arrange outreach vaccination, the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) of the Department of Health (DH) will launch the School Outreach Vaccination Pilot Programme and the Enhanced VSS Outreach Vaccination in the 2018/19 school year.

Under these two initiatives, the following **3 types of outreach vaccination** will become available to primary schools:

- a) Government Outreach Teams (DH Mode)
- b) Public-Private-Partnership Outreach Teams (PPP Mode)
- c) Enhanced VSS Outreach Vaccination

Government Outreach Team (DH mode)

DH will be responsible for delivering the entire outreach vaccination in primary schools by DH's own resources. DH will be responsible for procurement of SIVs, liaison with schools (with the assistance of EDB), delivery of vaccines to schools, conducting vaccination and arrangement on disposal of clinical waste.

Public-Private-Partnership Outreach Team (PPP mode)

DH will match interested VSS doctors with the participating schools to provide outreach vaccination. DH will be responsible for purchasing SIVs and the delivery logistics. DH will also be arranging disposal of clinical waste. Designated VSS doctors will make

appointment with the schools directly and send their own staff to obtain consent forms, check vaccination history, assess fitness for vaccination, provide the vaccination, enter vaccination record on eHealth system (subsidies), as well as observe for post-vaccination reactions. The VSS doctor should be responsible for their vaccination staff, to receive the vaccines, and to await for collection of unused vaccines and clinical waste.

Participating VSS doctors will be given HKD\$70 as injection fee for each dose of SIV given to primary school children during the outreach vaccination. They could not charge extra service fees. VSS doctors are required to provide second dose at schools for those children under 9 years of age who have never received SIV before. It is expected that the first dose should be given within 2 sessions and the second dose should be given within 1 session.

Enhanced VSS Outreach Vaccination

VSS doctors may also participate in the Enhanced VSS Outreach Vaccination. Enhanced VSS Outreach Vaccination applies to primary schools, kindergartens (KGs), child care centres (CCCs) and Kindergarten-cum-Child Care Centres (KG-cum-CCCs). VSS doctors have to liaise with schools on their own to provide vaccination. They are also responsible for purchasing SIVs, vaccine delivery, collection of remaining vaccines and clinical waste disposal.

Participating VSS doctors will be given HKD\$250 for each dose of SIV given to the students who are <u>Hong Kong residents</u> receiving vaccination during the outreach vaccination. HKD \$800 will be given to the VSS doctor for clinical waste disposal per vaccination session. Doctors could <u>not</u> charge extra service fee from the schools and the parents of the school children. Doctors need to submit claims via eHealth system (subsidies). Similar to the Pilot Programme, VSS doctors are required to provide second dose at schools for those children under 9 years of age who have never received SIV before.

Children who are Hong Kong residents and aged between 6 months to under 12 years have become an eligible group for subsidised SIV under VSS since 2016/17 season. School children from the same eligible group who are attending KG, CCC, KG-cum-CCC or primary school in Hong Kong can participate in the enhanced outreach vaccination in 2018/19.

Other VSS Outreach Vaccination

The Pilot Programme and Enhanced VSS Outreach Vaccination aim to improve SIV uptake rate among children, other people such as parents, family members, school staff are not eligible to join.

VSS doctors may continue to provide outreach vaccination under VSS for the other eligible groups (such as pregnant women, persons with intellectual disability, etc.) at doctor's clinic or at non-clinic settings. The vaccination subsidy will be increased to HKD\$210 for each dose of SIV given. The VSS doctors may charge extra service fee from the recipient. Assumptions for doctors' to assess his/ her manpower capacity to provide vaccination outreach under the PPP Mode of the Pilot Programme

- 1. Each school has around 500-900 students.
- 2. The actual number of students who will consent for vaccinations in each school may vary.
- 3. For each school, the PPP Outreach Team has to complete the first dose within 2 days and the second dose within 1 day.
- 4. The vaccination period for first dose of seasonal influenza will be from mid- October to December 2018. The second dose should be given at least 4 weeks after the first dose and should be completed by January 2019.
- 5. The outreach activity should be carried out at school hours and on school days (Monday to Friday).

Suggested manpower (for reference)

The suggested manpower for a primary school with 6 classes in each grade:

- The VSS doctor is responsible for the whole vaccination activity. The doctor should preferable to be present at the venue, or else should be reachable at any time during the activity.
- 1 team leader (The VSS doctor/ another doctor / a nurse) should be on-site and in-charge-of the whole
 vaccination activity. The duties including but not limited to ensuring proper maintenance of the cold
 chain of vaccines; proper administration of the vaccines, correct return of unused vaccines and proper
 handling of clinical waste, and also handling any incidents occurred on-site.
- 6 trained staff for injection
- Other supporting staff (to sign receipt of the vaccine; to wait for clinical waste collector to collect the clinical waste or vaccine supplier to collect the unused vaccine; to help set up; and to check records, etc.)
