Thank you for attending the briefing sessions on Recommendations on Seasonal Influenza Vaccination/ Pneumococcal Vaccination, Vaccination Subsidy Scheme (VSS) 2022/23 and Elderly Health Care Voucher Scheme (HCVS) held on 23 June 2022 (Thu) and 28 June 2022 (Tue).

Please note the following salient updates for the VSS 2022/23 season for your information and early preparation for the coming VSS 2022/23:

- Influenza transmission could increase when the non-pharmaceutical interventions and travel restrictions are lifted, leading to potential co-circulation of influenza and SARS-CoV-2, with additional burden on vulnerable populations and health systems. It is important to ensure that people who are at greater risk of influenza infection (e.g. health workers, older adults and pregnant women) are prioritised to receive seasonal influenza vaccination (SIV).
- 2. Flexibility could be exercised to provide COVID-19 vaccines with SIV <u>on the same visit</u> under informed consent.

We build a healthy Hong Kong and aspire to be an internationally renowned public health authority

- 3. Enrolled doctors must **maintain listing** in the Primary Care Directory (PCD) for continue enrolment in VSS in the 2022/23 season.
- All enrolled VSS doctors have to use <u>Purpose-built vaccine refrigerators (PBVR)</u> for vaccine storage by 2023/24 (may start in around October 2023).
- 5. **<u>Subsidy levels</u>** under VSS:
 - i. Seasonal influenza vaccination (SIV) HK\$260 per dose
 - ii. 23-valent pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine (23vPPV) HK\$400 per dose
 - iii. 13-valent pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV13) HK\$800 per dose
 - iv. SIV, 23vPPV, PCV13: Enrolled doctors may charge extra fee
 - v. Sinovac vaccine HK\$100 per dose for persons < 60 years old (calendar year);
 HK\$150 dose dose for persons > or = 60 years old (calendar year); Enrolled doctors should not charge extra fee
- 6. <u>e-consent</u> for SIV/ pneumococcal vaccination will be implemented in VSS 2022/23, details would be provided in due course.
- 7. Service Provider <u>eHealth System (Subsidies) login using iAM SMART</u> (Optional) has been implemented since May 2022.
