

Quarantine Facilities

Quarantine Centres

The Government has set up quarantine centres which currently accommodate people who are close contacts of confirmed cases, and people returning to Hong Kong from overseas countries or places requiring to stay at quarantine centres after risk assessment, but without compatible symptoms for compulsory quarantine. As of 9:00am on 28 June 2020, the occupancy of the currently operating quarantine centres are tabulated as follows:

Other Quarantine Facilities

The Government implemented a 14-day compulsory quarantine from 00.00am on February 8, 2020 on people who enter Hong Kong from the Mainland or who have been to the Mainland in the past 14 days preceding arrival at Hong Kong, including Hong Kong residents, Mainland residents and visitors from other places. And starting from March 25, 2020, the compulsory 14-day quarantine arrangements have also been extended to all persons arriving from or having stayed in Macao and Taiwan, in the past 14 days prior to arrival. Hong Kong residents will stay at home for quarantine. For non-Hong Kong residents who have arranged to stay at hotels or other dwelling places, they will conduct quarantine at the concerned hotels or dwelling places. If Hong Kong residents under compulsory quarantine are not able to arrange accommodation, they will be accommodated at one of the following Government facilities, namely Tso Kung Tam Outdoor Recreation Centre and Lady MacLehose Holiday Village.
