

## Quarantine Facilities

### Quarantine Centres

The Government has set up quarantine centres to accommodate people who are close contacts of confirmed cases, and people who enter Hong Kong from Wuhan or who have been to Wuhan [or countries/regions as announced by the Government](#), in the past 14 days preceding arrival at Hong Kong, but without any symptoms. The 4 currently operating quarantine centres are as follows:

### Other Quarantine Facilities

The Government implemented a 14-day compulsory quarantine from 00.00am on February 8, 2020 on people who enter Hong Kong from the Mainland or who have been to the Mainland in the past 14 days preceding arrival at Hong Kong, including Hong Kong residents, Mainland residents and visitors from other places. Hong Kong residents will stay at home for quarantine. For non-Hong Kong residents who have arranged to stay at hotels or other dwelling places, they will conduct quarantine at the concerned hotels or dwelling places. If Hong Kong residents under compulsory quarantine are not able to arrange accommodation, they will be accommodated at one of the following Government facilities, namely Tso Kung Tam Outdoor Recreation Centre, Sai Kung Outdoor Recreation Centre and Lady MacLehose Holiday Village.
