- 0:04 To align with the new phase of resumption of normalcy, further adjustment is made by the Government to the COVID-19 vaccination service arrangements.
- 0:09 If you are a member of the priority groups, including: individuals aged 50 or above; persons aged 6 months or above and with immunocompromising conditions; pregnant women; healthcare workers and persons aged 18 to 49 years with underlying comorbidities, you can receive an additional vaccine booster at least 6 months after the last dose or recovery from COVID-19 infection free of charge this year.
- 0:31 Other citizens who are not within the priority groups and have yet to receive the first three doses of COVID-19 vaccine, should make appointment for vaccination as soon as possible.
- 0:37 The latest vaccination venues are available on the designated website for the COVID-19 Vaccination Programme which also operates for eligible citizens to make appointments for COVID-19 vaccination, involving designated general outpatient clinics under the Hospital Authority and private clinic COVID-19 vaccination stations.
- 0:50 COVID-19 vaccination is listed as a regular service at specialist outpatient clinics of 13 public hospitals, citizens may receive COVID-19 vaccination at the time they attend medical appointments at the specialist outpatient clinics without booking for vaccination.
