in Latest Arrangement of COVID-19 Vaccination Series

- 0:03 COVID-19 vaccination service arrangements have been adjusted since the end of April.
- 0:07 To align with the new phase of resumption of normalcy, and to ensure the high risk groups, especially elderly and children can be protected by vaccination, citizens may make vaccination appointments for their children through online booking system. [Children Community Vaccination Centre at Hong Kong Children's Hospital provides SinoVac, BioNTech toddler and paediatric formulations vaccination service]
- 0:17 Starting from 2 June 2023, Gleneagles Hospital Hong Kong and CUHK Medical Centre would provide vaccination service at their outpatient clinics. [BioNTech toddler and paediatric formulations vaccination service is provided]
- 0:23 All Maternal and Child Health Centres (MCHCs) continues to provide vaccination service for children aged between 6 months and 4 years. [Walk-in SinoVac vaccination service is provided]
- 0:29 Starting from 1 June 2023, booking appointments for 7 designated MCHCs can be arranged via the online booking system. [BioNTech toddler formulation and SinoVac vaccination service is provided]
- 0:34 Students may continue to book their appointments for COVID-19 vaccination at 5 designated Student Health Service Centres (SHSCs).
 [Sinovac vaccines for children and adolescents aged 3 to 17 years; BioNTech paediatric formulation vaccines for children aged 5 to 11 years]
- 0:39 Service arrangement of 14 Elderly Health Centres (EHCs) remains unchanged to provide walk-in Sinovac vaccination service to elderly people aged 65 or above.
- 0:48 Other than aforementioned channels, elderly and children may also make appointments at designated general outpatient clinics (GOPCs) of the Hospital Authority or Private Clinic COVID-19 Vaccination Stations (PCVSs).
